- Training/Video Rental update A. Ven Graitis Member training is currently available and

 out in the next week.
- o In2vate Initiative A. Ven Graitis Member administrators now have access to In2vate's on-line training system. Courses can be assigned to any employee with internet access and a computer. A list of available courses has been distributed including Police and Fire/EMS professional courses, PEOSH required training, driver training, and antiharassment/discrimination training.
