EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR REPORT – J. Hall (NIP Group)

- 2016 Review and 2017 Goals Mr. Hall thanked the Commissioners and reported that all of the members up for renewal decided to renew with the PEJIF. He also reviewed the Fund services for 2016 and goals for 2017.
- o **Financial Fast Track Report Status YE 2016 –** Mr. Hall reported that the year-end Fast Track will be released as soon as the year-end actuarial report is finalized.
- Special Commissioners As the membership is now an even number, the Fund's Bylaws
 require the appointment of a Special Commissioner and alternate. These will be appointed based
 on an alphabetical rotation of the membership, at an upcoming meeting of the Board of
 Commissioners.



TREASURER'S REPORT - P. DeBlasio

- Mr. DeBlasio reported that monthly financial report and cash management account has been reviewed. He advised that the Fund has met all outstanding obligations and its financial position is secure. There were no questions.
- o Mr. DeBlasio also provided an overview of the performance of the Fund's investments during the 2016 Fund Year as of December 31, 2016.

SAFETY DIRECTOR – A. Ven Graitis (NIP Group)

- 2016 PEJIF Risk Control Recap Risk control had a very successful year with approximately 4,100 employees trained, 175 classes provided by various professional vendors, 260+ users of In2vate, over 450 users of distracted driver on line training, an SIP program awarding \$3,500, and the buy in of employees at every municipality, where safety committee meetings are regularly held. The focus on safety and risk control is shown in the loss experience which will be reviewed by the Claims group.
- MUTCD Markings Yellow Lines It has been clearly stated by the FHWA that colored markings between yellow lines, including a blue line for Police or red line for the Fire Department, are not appropriate and should not be used. The MUTCD does not permit markings between center lines or any blue pavement markings outside the context of parking spaces for users with disabilities. Any decision to remove colored lines should be done in accordance with road repair policies in the corresponding municipality, allocating resources to complete the project appropriately while considering the priority of jobs. There is also pending legislation allowing the use of colored lines which will be followed and communicated with members.
- Driver Safety for Law Enforcement Personnel Due to the steady frequency of auto losses, and the potential for catastrophic loss with automobiles, risk control will continue offering services including on line distracted driver training, on line SERVE training, CEVO and CMVO in person training, fleet program reviews, and assistance reviewing MVR check policies and procedures.
- Slips, Trips and Falls with cold weather upon us, slips and falls will likely be the number one driver of claims in the upcoming months. Supervisors should continue to promote safety, and doing work slowly and carefully in dangerous conditions, the use of proper PPE, and holding toolbox talks to provide reminders when appropriate.
- On-line Training through in2Vate and SERVE Risk control personnel are available to discuss on line training options.



 Fire Department Equipment Inspections – the recent ladder failure in the City of Passaic was discussed. Regular inspections of fire apparatus are mandatory, can prevent liability, save members money and stop injuries from occurring with personnel.

CLAIMS REPORT – C. Cyriax (NIP Group)

• Key Performance Indicators - Conrad Cyriax provided the Commissioners with the Claims Report. Key performance indicators of Claims Department activity were fully discussed including the number of new claims received and the sum of claims closed during the preceding month. Frequency trends affecting the Fund were discussed as well as other critical measurements of Claims Department activity such as closing ratio.
